In order to be eligible for Registration each player or their parent or guardian must:

- In the case of NEW PLAYERS provide for sighting, Date of Birth verification such as an Original Birth Certificate, Current Passport or Current Drivers Licence.
- Pay all fees.

The Management Committee determines the admission or rejection of an application under the rules of the club constitution.

A parent/guardian is required to sign this application on the understanding that they will, and that they will encourage their families
